



## Instructions

- ❖ With the 2014 World Championships round the corner, LMI introduces a set of puzzles appearing at the World Puzzle Championship.
- ❖ Due to the substantial large number of puzzles, we have divided the test into two parts: Day-1 (comprising of puzzles appearing in the first day of WPC) and Day-2 (comprising of puzzles appearing in the second day of WPC). Coincidentally, each day has 54 puzzles. Many of the puzzles are easy as we would like players to solve as many puzzles as possible.
- ❖ There is **no INSTANT GRADING**, **no BONUS POINTS** and this test will **not be considered for LMI Ratings**. It is a fun test primarily targeted as a WPC Practice Set.
- ❖ Day-1 will be open from **3<sup>rd</sup> August to 11<sup>th</sup> August** and the duration of the test is 150-minutes.
- ❖ Day-2 will be open from **5<sup>th</sup> August to 11<sup>th</sup> August** and the duration of the test is 180-minutes.
- ❖ There will be no separate Instruction Booklet for this test. You **must** refer to the official WPC IB for rules and examples.
